

ALL-TERRAIN ROUTE ORDINANCE

An ordinance to establish an all-terrain route ordinance pursuant to Section 23.33(8) of the Wisconsin Statutes.

The Town of Alma of Jackson County, Wisconsin does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish an all-terrain route and provide safe and enjoyable recreation consistent with public rights and intent.

Section 2. The provision of this ordinance shall apply to the following roadway describe in section 3. In the jurisdiction of the Town of Alma. The provision of this ordinance shall be enforced by local law enforcement agencies.

Section 3. The area designated as an all-terrain route shall be as follows:

That portion of Kovar Road beginning at the Village Limits of the Village of Merrilan, and ending at the intersection of Town Line Road, which is the boundary of Jackson and Clark County.
